No Numbers will be issued until registration papers and AQHA memberships have been verified by the show secretary. Be sure your papers show the correct owner. All exhibitors must have a current AQHA membership in his or her name **ONLY**. **We MUST SEE YOUR CARD!** If you do not have one, you can purchase it at the horse show. Photo copies of registration papers and membership cards are acceptable. Be prepared to leave copies with the show secretary.

Signed transfers &/or computer print-outs are not acceptable as proof of ownership or membership.

Select Amateurs may begin showing in the Select classes on their 50th birthday. You may NOT show in Select & Amateur with the same horse. You MAY show Novice and Select with the same horse.

Performance Halter: The **HORSE** must have earned an Open, Amateur, Youth, or Racing Register of Merit (ROM) for eligibility in this class. The show secretary must have proof in the form of a copy of the ROM certificate or a computer printout showing the date the ROM was issued. You do not have to be the owner of record at issuance.

11 & Under Walk/Jog classes are open to any breed of horse. No ownership or membership requirements. You may not enter classes requiring a lope or canter. You may show in AQHA showmanship and halter classes if all AQHA rules are met.

Arenas will be cleared when equipment is working in the arenas.

ALL DOGS must be leashed and under control of a responsible person. No dogs are allowed near the food vendor, arena gates or in the arenas. Loose dogs may be impounded. However, they may come to the office for their biscuits.

A valid driver's license and proof of insurance, either auto or home owners liability, is required of anyone operating any type of motorized vehicle. All scooters, bikes, carts, or the like, must be kept clear of any horse activity around the barns and all arenas.

NO skateboards allowed

Refund Requests must be in writing. Requests made prior to close of entries will be refunded in full. After 6/22 a vet certificate on his official letterhead, listing the actual reason, will be honored, **minus a \$25.00 office fee.** **No stall refunds after June 25.**

≧ MEC Facility Policies ≦

- ◆ MEC bills us for damages to stalls, barns, wash racks, etc. We will pass these fees on to you, so PLEASE, be careful. **Remove any nails** used in the stalls and tack rooms. There is an **MEC fine of \$100.00** per stall for left over nails. This cost will be passed on to you.
- ◆ Proof of Rabies vaccination may be required. **No dogs allowed off leash.**
- ◆ No dogs in concession area, food area, or in the bleachers.
- ◆ Parking in designated areas only. Do not block emergency access, fire lanes, or the water truck. You will be towed. No entrance in areas marked "private."
- ◆ All RV's, campers, or LQ's are subject to fees and must display "fees paid" stickers.
- ◆ Operators of any motorized vehicles must have a valid drivers' license and proof of insurance.
- ◆ Horses staying overnight must be a stall. Tying of horses to trailers or in temporary pens will not be allowed.
